### Disaster prevention safety exhibition items

Disaster prediction/preparation products and technologies, outdoor disaster prevention facilities, building and civil materials for disaster prevention, disaster prevention methods and technologies, rescue equipment, emergency evacuation facilities, personal safety equipment and building supplies, disaster recovery equipment, disaster safety communication networks, other disasters reduction products and technologies, etc.

### Fire safety exhibition items

Fire detection/alarming systems, fire prevention facilities, fire-fighting facilities and equipment, fire-fighting maneuver and fire suppression equipment, personal fire-fighting equipment (protective gear, etc.), fire damage reduction facilities, other fire prevention technologies and facilities, etc.

### Major visiting buyers
